Project Timeline					
Project Summary How will gifts to your project make a difference at Northeastern, the greater community, and/or your educational experience? What are you raising money for, and why should donors support your project?					
Project Budget Use your budget to determine your fundraising goals.					
Project Tagline 15 words or less.

Icon	Square At least 500 px x 500 px	.JPG or .PNG	Required . We suggest your organization's logo. Image will be cropped to a circle.
Banner	Horizontal 1920 px x 355 px	.JPG or .PNG	Optional. For best results avoid images with people and/or text.
Gallery	Horizontal 680 px x 400 px	.JPG or .PNG	One image is required. You can have up to four images.
